The restaurant's sommelier and general manager, Michal Drozdowski, was notably impressed by the Boschendal Grand Syrah, Bamboes Bay Sauvignon Blanc, and Bellingham Chenin Blanc. He confirmed plans to add these exceptional wines to Bottiglieria 1881's wine list, where they will enhance and complete the South African selection for their guests. This collaboration marks a significant milestone for the showcased brands in expanding their presence in Poland's fine-dining scene.
